



Murray River Gourmet Salt Flakes

1. Description (Colour, Appearance, Odour, Grade)

Description: Delicate salt flake crystals
Natural salmon pink appearance
Uniquely soft tasting and odourless
Crystal size range from 0.5 to 5mm

2. Technical Data – typical analysis

Analysis is on a dry weight basis

Typical free moisture is 0.5 g / 100g. Various elements and bound moisture account for the remaining .023%. All percentages are mass per mass basis.

3. Packaging and Identification

Product packaging is 50g, 150g resealable pouches, 250g blue box, 400g catering bags (not for re-sale) 200g Gift Tin, Grinder Units and refill pouches 200g.

4. Product Uses

As a garnishing salt, finishing, or during the food preparation process.

5. General Comments

Australia's Murray / Darling River region. Naturally occurring minerals create a high quality salt with unique flavour and appearance. The product is non perishable. This product is produced under the Australian & New Zealand Food Standards Code and under HACCP.
